

Nashville Electric Guitar

Sample instrument download for Kontakt 2-3 and Akai S5000 Samplers.

Nashville Electric Guitar combines a classic country/blues guitar with virtual effects pedals that control Kontakt's excellent built-in effects.

Plus, a Harmonizer allows for convincing lead playing.

There are 2 Sustain velocity layers, as well as a Mute layer that plays at lower velocities.



The Harmonizer

Just choose the key, or "Off" to bypass. At higher velocities, the Harmonizer adds drone notes that play the next higher octave or 5th, creating harmonies that DO NOT respond to pitch bend. This allows for the pitch-bending (using the pitch-bend wheel) of some notes, while the drone notes remain static. For instance, if you pitch-bend a note from D3 to E3 (in the key of "C or Am"), then a G3 will also play (without bending), creating a quite realistic guitar lick!

Installing for use with Kontakt 2:

Just drag the "NashvilleElecGtr" folder onto an appropriate location on your sample drive (hopefully in the same area as the rest of your Kontakt library). Load as you would any other Kontakt instruments.

Using with Akai S5000-6000, Z-series samplers:

The Akai S5000 programs reside with the samples in the Nashville E Gtr Samples folder. This is necessary because of the way Akai samplers load instruments. If you're using a SCSI CD-rom drive, just burn a CD-rom of the NashvilleElecGtr folder. If you're using Aksys (with the USB option installed), just drag the NashvilleElecGtr folder to the "Memory Icon in Aksys' browser.

Compatibility:

This product is guaranteed to work on Akai S5000, 6000, Z-series samplers, as well as Kontakt 2 or 3. If you are using it on any other system, you're on your own!
